MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: The 2010 Hazardous Material and Hazardous Waste Handling Training Courses

1. **General:**

a. The EPA Office of Solid Waste regulates hazardous waste under authority of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA). RCRA tightly regulates all hazardous waste from "cradle to grave". The subject training is designed to ensure the safe handling and proper management of Hazardous Material (HM) and Hazardous Waste (HW) in related activities and to provide awareness for transporting HM/HW. This course meets the EPA-RCRA and the Maryland Department of Environment (MDE) training requirement for owners and operators of hazardous waste treatment, storage, and disposal facilities. (Ref: 40 CFR 264.16, 40 CFR 265.16 & COMAR 26.13.05.02)

b. This training is offered to the Fort Meade workforce government employees only. High priority will be given to the unit's designated HW coordinators & their alternates, Environmental Officers & their alternates, and employees who routinely handle HM/HW.

2. **Schedule:** The following is a list of classes scheduled for the year 2010.

- a. 40-Hour Initial HM/HW Handling Course: **April 5-9; Aug 9-13**
- b. 8-Hour Re-certification: **Feb 26; Apr 2; Jun 25, Aug 6, Sep 13**

3. **Procedure:**

a. To request a training slot, please submit a completed and signed copy of Standard Form 182 (Authorization, Agreement and Certification of Training) - 1st two pages only to the DPW Environmental Division, ATTN: Andrea Thi, Bldg. 239 Ross Road, Stop # 5115.

b. Some organizations require that a signed SF 182 be returned to them after training is completed. The individuals who need their SF 182 signed by the instructor after completion of the course should bring the original form to the classroom, and return the completed signed original copy to your administrative office to obtain proper credit for your training.

4. **Cost:** These training courses are centrally funded by the DPW Environmental Division. Please notify the Environmental Division if you cannot attend your scheduled training at least one week prior to the training date or as soon as possible to allow for a replacement from the waiting list. Your cooperation in this matter is greatly appreciated.
